



Deuschtown Music Festival is committed to be a Zero Waste Event.

What is a Zero Waste Event?

In recognition of the impact of single-use items on our environment and health, DMF is partnering with the Pennsylvania Resources Council (PRC) to minimize waste headed to the landfill from the festival.

The term **Zero Waste** refers to **diverting 90% or more material from the landfill**. This is accomplished through material reuse, recovery, composting and recycling.

At DMF, **all vendors are serving their food and beverages in containers and with utensils that are compostable**. In doing so, and with your help, DMF can be a Zero Waste event!



How can I help?

Take your trash to a **Zero Waste Station** (see photo above) located throughout the festival and place your items in the appropriate **Recycling**, **Compost**, or **Trash Only** bin.

What can I recycle?

Only **aluminum cans** and **plastic bottles** are recyclable. All other plastics should be put in the Trash.

How do I know what is compostable?

All paper products (napkins) and food scraps are compostable. All items below are compostable- look for the **Green Stripe**, the words **Compostable** or the **BPI-certified logo** (below). Or, ask a Zero Waste team member!
